



O.T.A.TM Code of Conduct

The Ontario Taekwondo Association (O.T.A.TM) Code of Conduct applies to all athletes (Junior A and Senior), coaches, tournament committee members, officials and staff members when participating in any and all O.T.A.TM event(s). Annex A applies to Jr athletes, under the age of 16 years. Annex B applies to all athletes, coaches, officials and staff members of all ages representing Ontario and the O.T.A.TM at all other events, particularly Canadian National Events.

Failure to comply with the following requirements may result in removal from an event without reimbursement of any fees paid, suspension from future O.T.A.TM events for a specified period and/or complete suspension from participation as a competitor, coach, official or staff member in any or all future O.T.A.TM event(s).

- _____ I will act in a manner consistent with the spirit of fair play and responsible conduct.
- _____ I will acknowledge, respect and adhere to the authority of O.T.A.TM appointed event staff, tournament staff and team leader(s).
- _____ I will fully comply with the O.T.A.TM, Taekwondo Canada and the World Taekwondo Federation (WTF) uniform requirement.
- _____ I will refrain from the excessive use of performance-limiting drugs, including, but not limited to, tobacco and alcohol.
- _____ I will not use any substance on the Olympic Movement Anti-Doping Code, as enforced by the CCES.
- _____ I will abide by the policies and rules established by the O.T.A.TM, Taekwondo Canada and the WTF.
- _____ I will respect myself and others, including athletes, coaches, competitors, officials and spectators.
- _____ I will not engage in or tolerate any form of discrimination (gender, race, place of origin, athletic potential, colour, religion, age, sexual orientation, or mental or physical disability).
- _____ I will not engage in or tolerate any form of abuse (verbal, physical or sexual).
- _____ I will respect the property of others.
- _____ I will refrain from illegal or inappropriate behaviour that would deter from a positive image of me and the O.T.A.TM.
- _____ I will maintain a positive attitude and act in a way that will bring honour to me, my team, the sport of Taekwondo, the O.T.A.TM.

Annex "B" O.T.A.TM Code of Conduct for National & International Events

This annex applies to all athletes, coaches and staff representing Ontario and the O.T.A.TM at any out-of-province events, particularly Canadian National events. It is in addition to the policy stated in the main part of this document.

Failure to comply with the following requirements may result in removal from an event without reimbursement of any fees paid, suspension from representing Ontario and the O.T.A.TM at National or other events for a specified period and/or complete suspension from representing Ontario or the O.T.A.TM as a competitor, coach, official or staff member in any future event(s).

- _____ I will participate in all Ontario Team training sessions, whether they are held within Ontario prior to the event or at the event itself.
- _____ I will be present at all Ontario Team meetings, whether they are held within Ontario prior to the event or at the event itself.
- _____ If I am unable to attend a scheduled Ontario Team training session or meeting, I will advise the Ontario Team Manager or Head Coach as soon as possible before the event and provide compelling reasons for missing the event.
- _____ I will obtain and wear the Ontario Team uniform and tracksuit to all events.
- _____ I will provide my travel itinerary and accommodation plan to the Ontario Team Manager at least one (1) week prior to the event.
- _____ From arrival at the event to my departure from the event, I will keep the Ontario Team Manager advised of my whereabouts and activities.
- _____ I will comply with direction provided by the Ontario Team Manager or Ontario Head Coach with regard to my preparation and competition at the event.

Initial all statements to indicate you have read them and agree to comply with them.

I am aware that following failing to meet the aforementioned requirements may result in my removal from an event without reimbursement of any fees paid, my suspension from representing Ontario and the O.T.A.TM at National or other events for a specified period and/or my complete suspension from representing Ontario or the O.T.A.TM as a competitor, coach, official or staff member in any future event.
