### 2023 Taekwondo Ontario Talent ID Korea Training Camp

#### 1: Purpose

1.1 This is to provide the criteria used to determine the selected athletes for the 2023 Taekwondo Ontario Talent ID training camp to be held in various locations in South Korea on dates to be determined

#### 2: Minimum Criteria:

The following criteria must be met for athlete to be considered for selection.

- 2.1 Must be valid Taekwondo Ontario member in good standings.
- 2.2 Must have a valid Kukkiwon number.
- 2.3 Must have attended a minimum of 2 Taekwondo Ontario talent ID camps since October 2022.
- 2.4 Must be under the age of 22.
- 2.5 Must never have been a recipient of Taekwondo Canadas "Athlete Assistance Program (AAP).
- 2.6 Must have a valid Canadian Citizenship
- 2.7 Must agree and sign to abide by Athlete Conduct Agreement

#### 3: Selection Criteria:

- 3.1 Criteria for this event will be based on international results, national championships, and talent ID training camps. This is a Talent ID team; therefore, athlete selection will be based on both subjective and objective criteria.
  - 3.1.1: Results of all your G1, G2 and national events from Sept 2020 April 2023. Points collected will follow the same point schema used for all G ranking events for Senior and Junior divisions. Results in G-ranking events for a younger age category will only be given half value
  - 3.1.2 Attendance in Taekwondo Ontario Talent ID camps from May 2022 May 2023. Athletes will be given more points based on how often they attended the Talent ID camps.
  - 3.1.3 Athletes who scored higher on the Athletic Testing as well as other physical attributes will be taken into consideration in team selection
  - 3.1.4 Athletes attitude and engagement levels at the Talent ID training Camp will be taken into consideration in team selection

#### 4: Athlete Profile

Athlete must submit the following information in document format (see figure 1 for example) and email to specified email address on specified date.

- 4.1.1: Personal Information
  - Full Name
  - Email address
  - Date of Birth
  - Competition weight division
  - Current Weight
  - Height
- 4.1.2: Competition History
  - Results at 2022 National Championships (Specify age division, weight division, and number of fights won)
  - Results at 2023 National Championships (Specify age division, weight division, and number of fights won)
  - Results at all G-ranked events from Sept 2020 April 2023. (Specify age division, weight division, and number of fights won)
- 4.1.3: Talent ID camps
  - Date of Talent ID camp attended (Number of training sessions attended)

#### 5: Self-Funded Athletes

There will also be an option to attend as part of the Talent ID team for those not selected as a Full or Partial funded athlete, however athletes must meet the "Minimum Criteria" specified in "Section 2" of this document. Athlete must also be approved by the Taekwondo Ontario Head Coach
